### Explanation of Responses:

1. The Common Stock reported in this item was issued upon the settlement of a portion of a grant of Salary Stock Units ("SSUs) awarded on March 31, 2011 pursuant to the Company's Salary Stock Plan (the "GMSSP") and vested upon grant. The portion of this award currently payable was settled on March 31, 2011 in cash, less a portion withheld for taxes.

2. Each SSU is the economic equivalent of one share of the Company's common stock. Grants of SSU are fully vested when made and will be settled in three equal annual installments beginning one year after the date of the grant by the delivery of cash in an amount equal to the fair market value of the Company's common stock as of the applicable anniversary date of the SSU's grant. Under the GMSSP, the fair value of the Company's common stock as reported on the New York Stock Exchange, on which it is listed, on the date of the transaction, which was \$25.45.

3. The Common Stock reported in this item was issued upon the settlement of a portion of a grant of SSUs awarded on March 31, 2010.

4. On March 31, 2010, the employee received a grant of 4,327 SSUs of which 1,442 SSUs were scheduled to be payable on March 31, 2012. On November 1, 2010, the Company amended its certificate of incorporation to effect a stock split in which each issued and outstanding share of Common Stock was converted into three shares of Common Stock. Pursuant to the terms of the GMSSP, each issued and outstanding SSU was automatically converted into three SSUs, so that the employee was credited with a total of 12,981 SSUs granted on March 31, 2010 of which 4,326 SSUs became payable on March 31, 2012 5. The Common Stock reported in this item was issued upon the settlement of a portion of a grant of SSUs awarded on March 31, 2009.

6. On March 31, 2009, the employee received a grant of 1,386 SSUs of which 462 SSUs were scheduled to be payable on March 31, 2012. On November 1, 2010, the Company amended its certificate of incorporation to effect a stock split in which each issued and outstanding share of Common Stock was converted into three shares of Common Stock. Pursuant to the terms of the GMSSP, each issued and outstanding SSU was automatically converted into three SSUs, so that the employee was credited with a total of 4,158 SSUs granted on March 31, 2010 of which 1,386 SSUs became payable on December 31, 2010.

7. The SSUs do not have an expiration or exercise date or carry a conversion or exercise price.

8. The SSUs reported in this item were granted on March 31, 2012.
